This would leave students open to severe punishment under Title IX policies for actions as innocuous as asking someone out on a date or not using their pronouns. By redefining harassment more broadly than the *Davis* standard and including gender identity into Title IX, Biden and his Department of Education are undermining Supreme Court decisions and eviscerating the value of the rule. These policies will kill free expression and open discourse on campuses nationwide. In order to achieve a worthwhile education, students must be able to express their thoughts and opinions, no matter without fear of reprisal from the university or the state."
